DIFFERENCE BETWEEN SEALS

Now that you know the difference between the standard and sealed parts, it is time to know more about the seals that you will see on different types of containers.

P-Seal

P-Seal is the type of seal that is used on most sealed containers. Paired with P-Seal Track and BOSS Multi-Seal, a one component curing adhesive for adhering seals to metal containers, the P Seal provides a tight seal on roll-off container tailgates.



E Seal

E-Seal is a type of seal that is found on poly boxes, double rolling roof and some sealed roll off containers. It is applied with a piece of flat bar and then riveted down to keep it in place giving the container the quality seal it needs.



T Seal

T-Seal is a type of seal that would be seen on the lids of containers. An example would be a double rolling roof. It is applied with angled steel to keep it in place giving the container the quality seal it needs.
